Our tendency is to think that the poor need our “stuff”. If that were the case, the way to eliminate poverty would be for the government to write bigger welfare checks. We all know that won't work. That is because poverty is not primarily a lack of material possessions but a mindset of hopelessness. A person trapped in poverty doesn't perceive that they have any options to change their situation. To hopeless people there's no more hope-inspiring news than the gospel.

The gospel penetrates when it is **incarnated**--wrapped up in the life of a person who cares. That's the model Jesus gave us. The Christmas story is that “the Word became flesh and dwelt among us” (John 1:14a NASB). The idea behind the word “dwelt” is that in the person of Jesus, God “pitched His tent” among us, He “moved into the neighborhood” (The Message).
