How To Share The Gospel

I'm convinced that the poor need the gospel more than anything else. My favorite method of sharing the gospel is one I learned decades ago called, "The Romans Road". I like it because it turns the person directly to the Bible to learn how to be saved. Here it is with an explanation of what each verse tells us about salvation:

Romans 1:16 The word gospel means "good news". **Everyone** who believes this good news can be saved.

Romans 3:23 Everyone has sinned and fallen short of God's standard.

Romans 6:23 What we deserve for our sin is spiritual death—to be separated from God in hell. On the other hand, the gift God freely offers us is eternal life in Christ. A gift can't be earned, only accepted or rejected.

Romans 5:8 God showed us how much he loves us by sending Christ to die as our Savior while we were still sinners. You don't need to become a better person before you can come to God. Come as you are.

Ephesians 2:8-9 We are saved by putting our trust in God's grace (i.e. undeserved kindness). Since it is not on the basis of our good deeds, there is no room for boasting.

Romans 10:9-13 You must be willing to profess Jesus as your Lord and believe God raised him from the dead so you can have a living relationship with Him. If you call upon the name of the Lord you will be saved.
